

GENERAL COMMENTS ON THE MONTH.

WITH THE HIGHEST DAILY TEMPERATURE OF ONLY 12C ON BOTH THE 1ST AND 15TH, NOVEMBER HAD ITS COLDEST DAY SINCE 1976 AND THE THIRD COLDEST IN OVER 30 YRS. DESPITE THIS, THE AVERAGE TEMPERATURES HAVE BEEN ALMOST NORMAL, RANGING FROM 12C ON THE 1ST AND 15TH TO MINUS 3.5C ON THE 28TH.

RAINFALL AT 58MM HAS BEEN ONLY 85% OF EXPECTATION, THE WETTEST DAY BEING THE 18TH WITH A FALL OF 12MM. RAIN FELL FOR A TOTAL OF 54 HOURS IN THE MONTH. SET AGAINST THIS IS THE TOTAL OF 31 HOURS OF BRIGHT SUNSHINE, THE LOWEST NOVEMBER TOTAL SINCE RECORDS BEGAN HERE IN 1956.

FOG OCCURRED ON 5 MORNINGS AND AIR FROST ON 3. FROST WAS RECORDED ON THE GROUND ON 11 OCCASIONS, WITH 9 DAYS BEING TOTALLY SUNLESS. WINDS WERE A LITTLE DOWN ON NORMAL AT 12 MPH, THOUGH NO GALE FORCE GUSTS WERE RECORDED.
