GENERAL COMMENTS ON THE MONTH. JUNE HAS BEEN A POOR MONTH. SUNSHINE AT 129HRS WAS ONLY TWO THIRDS OF THE USUAL, WITH 3 TIMES THE NUMBER OF SUNLESS DAYS. IT WAS THE THIRD DULLEST RECORDED SINCE 1956, ONLY 1964(128HRS) AND 1987(107HRS) BEING WORSE. RAINFALL WAS 20% ABOVE AVERAGE, RAIN FALLING ON ALL BUT 11 DAYS. THE WETTEST DAY (30TH) PRODUCED 13MM (0.52IN) IN 4 HOURS. HOWEVER, IT IS STILL ONLY THE 4TH MONTH OUT OF THE LAST 12 TO REGISTER ABOVE AVERAGE RAINFALL. TEMPERATURES HAVE BEEN UNEXCEPTIONAL, NO HOT DAYS (>250 OR 77F) BEING RECORDED. THE MAXIMUM OF 24.70 (76F) ON THE 26TH WAS THE LOWEST JUNE MAXIMUM SINCE THE 18,20865F) OF JUNE 30TH 1972. THUNDER WAS HEARD ON 4 OCCASIDINS, AND THE MONTH WAS UNUSUALLY CLOUDY THOUGH LESS WINDY THAN NORMAL.
