highest maximum was 28.6C (83F) on the 29th. In all 5 days were hot (temps. above 25C (77F). We have not, however, experienced similar heatwaves to 90/91 Sunshine has also been above average by as much as 16 hours, the sunniest day being the 10th with 12.6 hours. No day was sunless, the worst being the 30th with 0.3 hour.

One thunderstorm was noted on the 6th, with both cloud cover and humidity above expectation.
