## THE WEATHER OF OCTOBER 1991.

October was a variable month with a warm and sunny start, cold middle and a dull and wet end.

Rainfall continues below the 30-year norm at 51mm (2.01in), 83% of usual for the month, though the 17 days of rain were above expectation.

Five ground frosts were noted, the most severe of -2.6C (27F) on the 6th No air frost occurred. Both the mean maximum of 13C (55F) and the mean daily of 9.8C (50F) were below normal for October.

Sunshine was 12 hours less than customary, the 9 sunless days being the worst since 1982 and the 8th worst on record.

Twenty-four gale foce gusts were noted over 2 days, the strongest to 38 knots (44mph) on the 17th.
