here at 7.5C (46F). All temperatures, air, soil and radiation, were well above the 30-year means by as much as 4C. Air temperatures ranged from 15.5C (60F) on the 8th, to -0.3C (31F) on the 26th.

Rainfall totalled 62.4mm (2.46ins), about normal, though it rained on 19

days, 3 above expectation. No snow, hail or sleet was noted.

Sunshine at 114 hours was 11% above the 30-year mean, with 7 sunless days,

about average for March. The 26th saw 10 hours of bright sunshine, well below the 11.6 hours recorded on March 29th 1965.

It was a windy month with gusts above 40 knots on 2 days and a total of 7 days with gusts above gale force (34 knots). The mean hourly speed of 10.4

Air frost occurred on 2 nights and ground frosts on 15, both down on average.
