NOVEMBER MARKS THE END OF AUTUMN AND IT CAN THROW UP EXCEPTIONAL WEATHER. A NORMAL MONTH WOULD SEE 6 AIR AND 11 GROUND FROSTS. IN 1965 THERE WERE 15 AIR FROSTS AND IN 1985 AND 1993, 19 GROUND FROSTS.

THE WORST INCIDENCE OF LYING SNOW WAS IN 1962 WHEN IT LAY ON 6 DAYS, IN 1981 IT LAY ON ONE DAY, BUT IN 1981 SNOW OR SLEET

OCCURRED ON 12 DAYS INSTEAD OF THE CUSTOMARY 2. THE WORST GROUND FROST WAS OF -11.7C ON NOV 14 1965.

10 DAYS WERE TOTALLY SUNLESS. THIS YEAR SAW 14 OVER THE MONTH.

IN THE MIDIANDS FOR OVER 300 YEARS WITH A MEAN DAILY OF 9.7C.

THIS NOVEMBER WAS THE MILDEST ON RECORD HERE AND PROBABLY THE MILDEST

NOVEMBER CAN ALSO BE DULL. FROM 15/11/56TO 20/11/56 THERE

WERE 12 DAYS WITH NO SUN AT ALL, AND FROM 11/11/57 TO 22/11/57
