1965 THERE WERE 15 AIR FROSTS AND IN 1985 AND 1993, 19 GROUND FROSTS. THE WORST INCIDENCE OF LYING SNOW WAS IN 1962 WHEN IT LAY ON 6 DAYS. IN 1981 IT LAY ON ONE DAY, BUT IN 1981 SNOW OR SLEET OCCURRED ON 12 DAYS INSTEAD OF THE CUSTOMARY 2. THE WORST GROUND FROST WAS OF -11.7C ON NOV 14 1965.

NOVEMBER CAN ALSO BE DULL. FROM 15/11/56TO 20/11/56 THERE WERE 12 DAYS WITH NO SUN AT ALL, AND FROM 11/11/57 TO 22/11/57 10 DAYS WERE TOTALLY SUNLESS. THIS YEAR SAW 6 OVER THE MONTH.

NOVEMBER MARKS THE END OF AUTUMN AND IT CAN THROW UP EXCEPTIONAL WEATHER. A NORMAL MONTH WOULD SEE 6 AIR AND 11 GROUND FROSTS. IN
